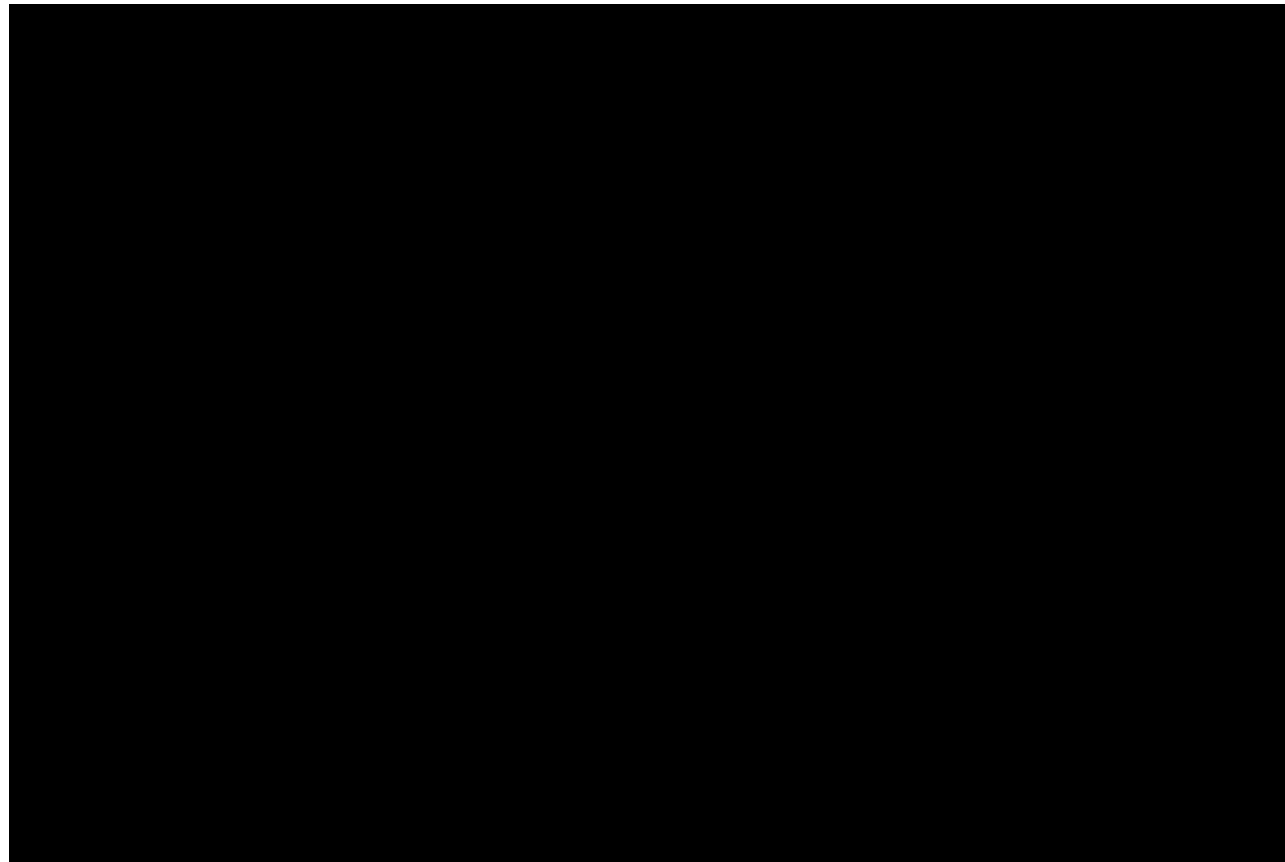

Glacier Explorers (Approx. 150 mins) (Weather Permitting). Proceed to Christchurch

Cruise around the Tasman Glacial Lake in one of our boats and experience the enormity of NZ's largest glacier as you weave in and out of floating icebergs. It's a surreal and mesmerising experience in a totally unique environment. No two days are the same on the Tasman Lake with a constant shifting of conditions, which simply adds to the magic of this very special place. A trip on Glacier Explorers is a unique opportunity to truly feel small as the lateral moraines, which are sharp-crested piles of glacially transported rocks and debris that are dropped by the ice as it melts, rear up almost 200m. The lateral moraines remind us of the grand scale that the glacier has reached in previous times. The whole trip is approximately 3 hours, and you can expect to spend approximately one hour on the lake. Child age limit might apply. Walking is required through alpine scenery to reach the Glacier. Guests must be fit and able to walk the 1.5km to / from the lake edge in 25 mins.

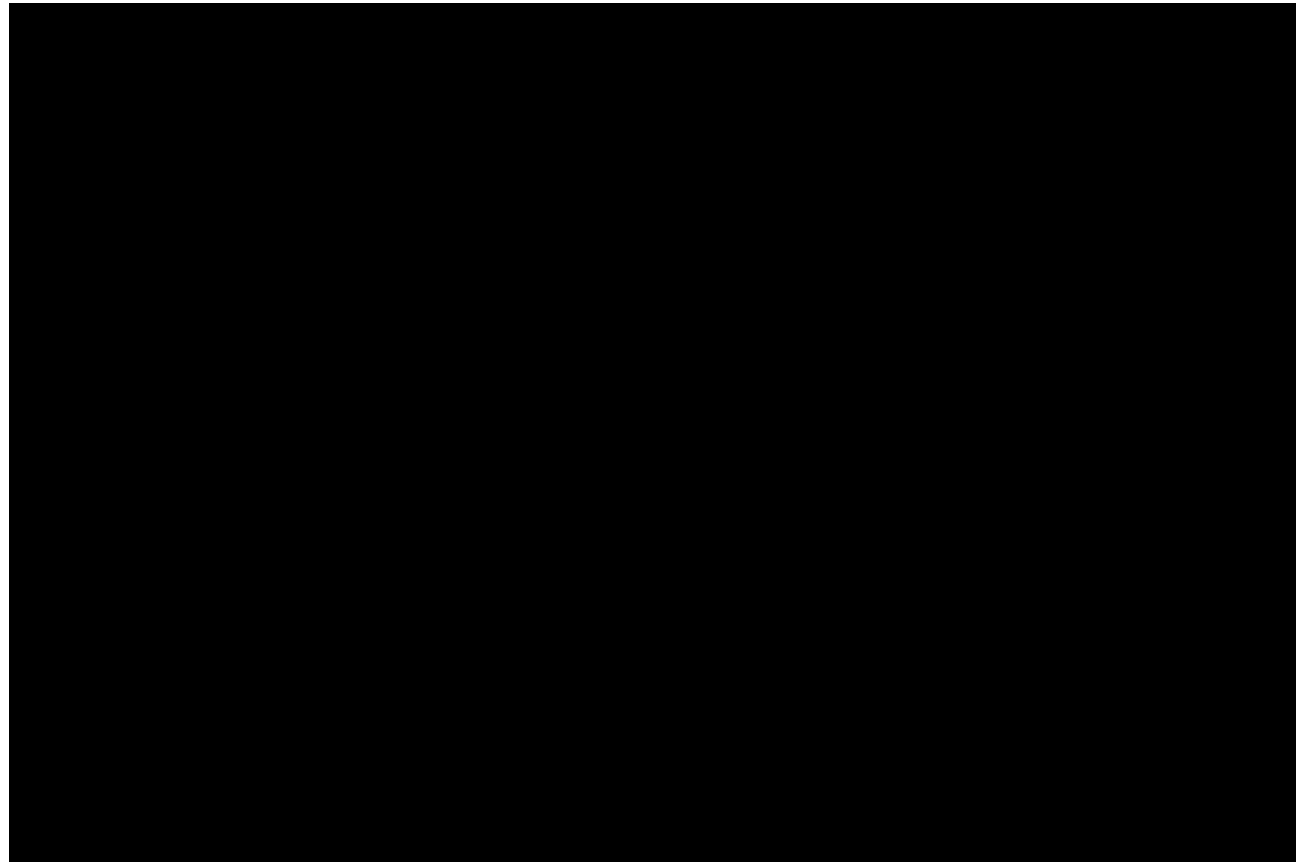
Day 18

- It is mandatory to pay AUD 5 per person/per day for Australia Part and NZD 5 per person per day for New Zealand part. Our Tour Manager will be collecting the same on Day 1 of the Tour.
- PCR test in India, Australia and New Zealand
- Applicable Government Taxes are additional.
- The tour cost does not include POE charges and passport charges.
- No portorage included.
- Any expenses of personal nature such as portorage, laundry expenses, mini-bar, mineral water, telephone charges, food and drink that are not a part of the package.
- Additional Meals that is not mentioned in the above itinerary.
- Cost of excursions, city sightseeing, entrance fees and local guides availed of by the passengers, other than that mentioned in the above itinerary.

Note:

- Optional Tours are dependent on weather conditions and subject to operational feasibility by the local vendors.
- Prices subject to change by the local vendors without notice.
- All optional activities will have to be booked and paid to your Thomas Cook Tour Manager or representative on day 01 or day 02 of the tour. All payments to be made in AUD in Australia and NZD in New Zealand only (Credit cards not accepted).
- Optional tours are booked and paid on 100% non-refundable and non cancellation policy.
- Some activities mentioned above as Pre Booking required needs to be booked from India or your home country only.
- Some activities mentioned above as Pre Booking preferable - We highly recommend to book in advance as these activities gets full very fast and might not be available on tour.
- Medical condition applies.
- TCS and GST will be additional if paid in India.

Important Notes:

Airline and Airfare:

- The airfare is based on the fare structure existing as on 1st Oct, 2023. Any further increase in the airfare due to an increase in the fuel price, change in Government regulations, taxes, etc., charged by the airline will have to be borne by the passengers.
- Passengers missing flights - In such cases the entire ticket/booking gets a no show and stands cancelled. A new return ticket needs to be purchased by the passengers.
- For prices and departure dates from your hub city please contact our local sales offices/travel agents.
- Cost of Travel to Hub City is not a part of the package.

Hotels:

- This Package does not offer city center hotels. Hotels will be located in the airport area or on the outskirts.
- As a 3rd person in a triple room, most hotels offer roll-away beds and room size will be the same as double room.
- For Child with bed: At times hotel don't have enough roll-away beds, in that case they might give a double and a separate single room.
- A person 12 years and below is considered child and above 12 years, an adult.
- Hotel rooms may not be air conditioned / air cooled nor will fans be provided. Air conditioning / cooling in hotels are set as per weather conditions.
- Functioning of Air cooling / Air conditioning in hotels is subject to official declaration of summer by the local authority.
- Due to international events and trade fairs you may have to stay in hotels further away from the city.
- Any damages caused to the hotel rooms / Coach during the stay shall be payable by the passengers.
- We also reserve the right to substitute a hotel of similar class if it is deemed advisable or necessary.
- Hotels in certain cities are not offering buffet breakfasts due to health regulations. If the same does not change by the time the tours operate, we will organize breakfasts at Indian / local restaurant.

Coaches:

- Coaches are an important part of your journeys and we request our guests to keep the coach clean.
- Due to hygiene factors it is not permitted to use toilets in the coach. However, we will make comfort stops during long drives.
- Eating and drinking is not permitted in the coach.
- Due to limited boot space in the coach we suggest you to carry one check-in bag and one hand bag per person only
- Due to parking regulations and designated drop off and pick up points it is not possible to stop at all the places during the city tour. Tour Manager / Local Representative will try his/her best to stop coach wherever possible for a photo stop.
- Coaches do not have a wheelchair access. There are steps to board / alight from the coach.
- Coaches are forbidden inside most of the historic city centers; to preserve them from damage caused by pollution and getting overcrowded. Most of your sightseeing will be done by local buses and by foot in the historic and heritage centers.

Meals:

- Meals are pre-set and a-la carte is not possible.
- On certain Days packed lunch will be provided.

Sightseeing:

- Due to logistical reasons certain departures may have amendments or reverse the itinerary. However, all the services / inclusions will remain the same.
- Generally, you will have to walk at sightseeing places, amusement parks and at the airports sometimes for a long distance; however the same will be timely instructed by the Tour Manager. It is advisable to carry good pair of comfortable sports shoes. The Tour Manager and the Driver will do their best to get you as close to the Monuments as possible.
- Every Site / Monuments has its own set of rules and regulations. We need to respect this and ensure that we follow the same.
- All our visits are booked in advance to avoid delays, at the same time there may be delays caused due to overcrowding, local regulations, security check etc.
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General:

- On some occasions you may have to join another group in case the group does not have adequate members.
- A local representative or a driver may only be there to assist you during your initial part of the tour.
- Security alerts and random closures might affect the itinerary.
- Please take extra care of your personal belongings while on the tour, every country you travel to is prone to thefts and bag snatching. Thomas Cook will not be liable for any loss of belongings / baggage.
